### CLASS 1 SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG

- 1 **McCalls Samandal Jack of Diamonds.** - Black brindle, correct ear & eye placement, head long & strong with enough turn, mouth level, good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, straight front strong straight pasterns, feet could be tighter. Well sprung rib, shortest of backs, strong well muscled quarters. Moved well in front, a little close behind but with drive, held top line on the move, good animation, handled well. RDB
- 2 **Maldens Jagers Wonder.** - White with red head marking. Good ear placement and enough head, kind eye spoilt expression a little, mouth fault, well made, good size, good bone, straight front, moved parallel both ways but lacked drive. A little lethargic today.
- 3 **Whites Freddie Long Socks.**

### CLASS 2 PUPPY DOG

- 1 **Ogdens Arren Bull Finmac Cumal** - White with eye mark. Very typy, with plenty of bone, power packed head with turn & fill, wicked eye, good ear placement, mouth fault, strong reachy neck into correct shoulders, strong straight front into strong pasterns, tight cat feet, very masculine for age and a real showman with it. Moved parallel both ways with good drive and reach. BD & RBIS
- 2 **Brooks Kellouacy the Patriot** - Black brindle heavyweight. Well marked good eye and ear placement, head filled right up with bags of turn, incorrect mouth, strong round bone, straight pasterns carrying to much weight. Moved OK behind and a little wide in front.
- 3 **Smalleys Briden Solid Silver**

### CLASS 3 JUNIOR DOG

- 1 **Marchant & Embleys Tiger Shark** - Well marked brindle & white, good length of head would like more fill & turn, correct mouth good ear placement, eye a little bold, reachy neck well laid shoulders good front & pasterns, cat feet strong bone needs to body up moved parallel with drive.
- 2 **Melrines Kenmill to Dark Prince.** - Dark brindle, enough head good ear & eye placement, making correct expression, mouth fault, adequate bone, front needs to tighten the rest hard to asses as he played his handler up today.

### CLASS 4 NOVICE DOG.

- 1 **Sheehy's Cwmdulais Geralt** - Well marked black brindle, super strong head with plenty of turn and fill, wicked eye and ears bang on top, mouth fault, real heavyweight out at the elbow, well sprung ribs, well muscled powerful quarters moved parallel with drive behind, wide in front.

- 2 **Houstons Jaznix African Devil** - Big white, well made, good eye and ear placement, head needs more fill, enough turn, mouth fault, good reach of neck, good front pasterns, cat feet needs to muscle up, moved parallel, lacked drive.

#### **CLASS 5 POST GRADUATE DOG.**

- 1 **McCalls Samandal Jack of Diamonds**  
 2. **Cserfassi - Youngs - Sanco Rock Solid** - Gleaming Red brindle, beautiful head with turn and fill, wicked eye, mouth fault, a little upright in shoulder, straight front, terrific strong bone, strong straight pasterns into tight cat feet. Moved well behind, a little wide in front.  
 3 **O'Neils Kenex Jazz Singer**

#### **CLASS 8 SPECIAL BEGINNERS BITCH**

1. **Bulbrum Porcelain Queen** - A good sized white bitch which remains elegant & feminine. A lovely profile to her head, which is nicely filled, mouth correct. Elegant long sweeping neck, which leads to her well placed shoulders. Straight front and good depth of chest. Nice short back and good top line. Well angulated hind quarters which completes a pleasing overall outline to this bitch. Moved & handled well.  
 2. **Shanson Black Shadow at Louka.** - Tri Colour, nicely made heavy weight bitch with strong head, mouth fault. Good length of neck and straight front, short back & good top line. Powerful hind quarters. Handled well.

#### **CLASS 9 PUPPY BITCH.**

1. **Kilacabar ice ice baby at Ducassos** - Strong head but feminine white bitch with red ears. Lovely turn and profile didn't use her ears to finish the picture. Good mouth, lovely long neck and good top line. Straight front and well angulated hind quarters. Unfortunately not too happy in the ring today.  
 2. **Kearby Curacao at Mistlebrook** - Another strong headed bitch / black brindle. Good profile and plenty of fill, good ear placement, unfortunately mouth not correct. Nice long neck with good shoulder placement. Perfect front and good line, really short back, well angulated powerful hind quarters, moved and handled well.

#### **CLASS 10 NOVICE BITCH.**

1. **Erralcular Geordie Girl.** - Tri Coloured bitch of terrier type nicely put together. Head lacking power and finish. Level Mouth. Good ear set, lovely long neck and good top line. Straight front, movement good.  
 2. **Loulea I am so sweet** - White with black ears, head lacking classic profile and mouth not correct. Nice short back and good angulated hind quarters

#### **CLASS 11 JUNIOR BITCH.**

1. **Romagna Penny Lane** - Good all round bitch, white with brindle ears. Powerful long head with correct mouth. Good length of neck and well-placed shoulders, good front and neat feet, nice top line with powerful quarters moved and handled well.  
 2. **Dajan foxy Lady** - Pretty little bitch, lovely profile, correct mouth, short back and good hind

quarters. Feet could be better, moved behind than in front.

1. **Bullard Geisha girl of Astasia.** - A really showy white. Good head with keen alert expression, lovely sweeping profile and nicely filled, elegant long neck with good shoulder placement. Straight front feet could be better, short back and good top line, lovely angulated quarters moved well both ways, pushed hard for best bitch, lost only on the hard condition of the winner. **BEST BITCH and BEST IN SHOW**
2. **Star's 'n' stripes of Merlindan.** - A well-made brindle & white, good strong head with lovely profile, mouth correct. Long neck and good shoulder placement. Good top line and nicely angulated hindquarters. Moved and handled well
