CLASS 1 SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG: 3 ENTRIES – 1 ABSENT

1st Jones - Scrumpy Jack

3 year old black brindle. Nicely filled head with adequate profile and good ear placement, good reach of neck into nice level topline, good bone and substance. A little lack lustre on the day. Moved well both ways.

2nd Maldens - Jagers Wonder

White with red ear marks, 6 year old dog, looking his years. Well filled head, a little lacking in profile, mouth incorrect.

Nice make and shape, bone and rear angulation. Moved a little close behind.

CLASS 2 PUPPY DOG: 6 ENTRIES – 3 ABSENT

1st Hind & Fowlers - Mitzstaff Diamond Geezer

Very compact, well constructed, well balanced white dog, lovely well filled head with lots of expression, ears bang on top. Mouth level. Good reach of neck into lovely short back, nice topline moved well, lacked a little drive. Very keen, really enjoyed his outing. Shown and handled well.

2nd Wicks - Red Blooded Lord English

Very substantial brindle and white dog. Very powerful head with lots of fill and turn. Mouth incorrect. Lots of bone and substance, lovely fore chest, going to be a real heavyweight, a very different type from 1st placed. A real handful, moved better going than coming.

3rd Feher - Roughhouse Bedford Trucker

Lightweight solid brindle, lovely rich colour, head lacking a little power, otherwise very pleasing. Wicked eye with ears right on top, well constructed. Moved well both ways, lacking a little maturity in this class.

CLASS 3 JUNIOR DOG: 6 ENTRIES – 3 ABSENT

1st McGregor's - Merlindan Sentinal. BD and BIS.

Lots to like about this very powerful white dog, oozing masculinity and shown in good hard condition. Strong Powerful head, good depth of muzzle and filled right up. Mouth correct. Good ear placement, punishing expression, lovely straight front and well formed chest, well defined second thigh and lovely neat feet. Good make and shape although tail set a little high. Moved with power and drive. Shown and handled well.

2nd Hawkers - Terrakular Mighty Monty

Good sized tri-colour Dog. Well constructed, not quite the power of 1st placed, but still very pleasing to the eye. Nice profile with adequate fill, ears set a little low with a rather kind eye. Mouth incorrect. Very well marked and put together.

Good bone and well placed shoulders with a nice clean topline. Moved well both ways.

3rd Hutchings - Terrakular Titan

Very nice, solid black brindle dog. A real heavyweight, good head, well filled with adequate profile. Mouth level. Well made with lots of bone. A little overcome by the day, didn't show to his full potential.

CLASS 4 NOVICE DOG: 8 ENTRIES – 4 ABS

1st Potburys - Red Warrior

Nice powerful, rich red dog. Good well filled head adequate profile. Mouth correct. Good depth of chest, nice straight front and very neat feet. Moved a little close behind. Nice quality dog shown and handled well enjoyed his outing.

CLASS 5 POST GRADUATE DOG: 4 ENTRIES – 1ABS

1st Brookes - Kelcoucy The Patriot

Tri-colour. Nice compact little dog with a powerful head, lots of depth, ears set a little low. Mouth incorrect.

Well constructed balanced dog. Good bone with lovely cat like feet, good reach of neck and nice topline.

Moved well both ways. Shown and handled well.

2nd Sheeheys - Cwmdulais Gerallt For Afanbull

Very powerful heavyweight black brindle dog. Lots of type and substance powerful head.

Mouth incorrect. Adequately

constructed, a little stuffy in the neck. Moved a little wide in front.

3rd Jones - Scrumpy Jack

Although very nice dog - lacked the power of 1 and 2. *See Special Beginners Dog for critique.*

OPEN DOG: 3 ENTRIES – 1 ABS

1st Smalleys - Briden Carbon Copy RBD

Black brindle, up on his toes and looking very hard and fit. Gleaming black jacket, harsh to the touch. Sweeping

profile with good fill, nice ear placement with wicked eye. Mouth correct. Good reach of neck super topline. Would like

a little more rear angulation, good tail set. Moved a little close behind. Looked in immaculate condition shown and handled well.

2nd Maldens - Jagers Wonder

CLASS 7 VETERAN DOG OR BITCH: 3 ENTERED 2 ABS.

1st Chants - Baptism of Fire

Pure white bitch pushing 11 years of age, well constructed - bounded up the mat like a junior to rapturous applause.

Class 8 Special Beginners Bitch (2)

1st Afanbull Bull Bombers Angel, Nice black brindle bitch, with good head and profile with a correct mouth, but not the best of movers.

2nd Shanson Black Shadow At Louka, Nice black bridle bitch, with a nice head and profile, she does have a mouth fault, but moved well both ways.

Class 9 Puppy Bitch (10)

1st Karmara Cause A Commotion, A first-class white bitch, showing all the classical type.

Very well developed for her age. With a beautiful well filled head, good profile, correct mouth and a pleasing expression, good top line, good front with good bone and substance but still maintaining her feminine side, moved adequately both ways. Handled and showed well. RBIS & BPIS.

2nd Ducassos Right By Me Briden, Another first-class bitch, a different type than 1st more terrier type. Still a little immature compared to 1st, with a nice head not has filled as 1st, but with a stunning profile and a correct mouth. With a good top line, good front and also moved adequately both ways. Handled and showed well. RBB. In my option this was the best class of the day and it's great to see that there are such good bitches up and coming.

3rd Fieldhall Lets Rock At Simsky.

Class 10 Junior Bitch (2)

1st Kenmilltri Red Devil, A pleasing red bitch, very feminine with nice head and correct mouth. Moved well both ways.

Class 11 Novice Bitch (9)

1st Kellouacy Lippy Chick, Good well developed bridle bitch, nice head level bite with a nice profile. Moved adequately both ways.

2nd Afanbull Murcy Milly, Another good black brindle bitch, good head and profile, with correct bite but both canines missing ?? Movement was a little close behind.

3rd Kearby Curacao At Mistlebrook.

Class 12 Post Graduate Bitch (5)

1st Kilacabar Ice-Ice Baby at Ducassos, Another nice white bitch, good well filled head with correct mouth, good front and moved well both ways.

2nd Monarchs Mischief, Very nice white bitch, who really enjoyed herself. Good head and mouth and moved adequately both ways, could have carried a bit more weight. But a very close decision with 1st.

Class 13 Open Bitch (4)

1st Targyt Dusky Dawn of Dodecote, Very nice bridle bitch in excellent condition. Well filled head, good profile and correct mouth. Good front with nice top line. Moved well both ways.

2nd Louka Lady in Red, Nice feminine red bitch. Good head and mouth but lacked a little fill. Good front and moved well both ways. Handled and showed well.

3rd Shanson Black Shadow At Louka.

Class 14 Special Brood Bitch (7)

1st Boarean Breen At Mistlebrook, Present white bitch, showing good feminine lines. Adequate head with correct mouth. Moved adequately both ways.
