SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG (7, 1A)

1st. Jones' SCRUMPY JACK.

Bl/B Head with good roman finish, good bone, moved better in front than behind.

2nd. Richards' YBRAD SIMPLY RED.

R/W Different type to 1 more compact, good bone, shorter back than 1.

3rd. Maldens' LITTLE BROWN JUG AT LOUKA.

CLASS 2. PUPPY DOG (3, 0A)

1st. Smalleys' BRIDEN CARBON COPY.

Bl/B 6 Month old beautiful head turned and filled, straight front, short back, good mouth pushed for best dog, his turn will come. (Res B.D. & B.P.)

2nd. O'Neils' HALLGARTH DEVILS ADVOCATE WITH KHLOLANDER.

10 Month white dog, big heavyweight, head needs to finish, good mouth, big round bone making his handler work hard moved better in front than behind.

3rd. Borlands' BADLESMERE BETTER DAYS.

CLASS 3. JUNIOR DOG (6, 1A)

1st. Godsalls' NEVERLAND HOUSE MASTER.

White with ear patches, strong head filled and turned, good mouth, good front & feet, well bent stifle, moved well in front a little close behind. Best Dog, RBIS, BOS.

2nd. Holbrooks' MERLINDAN ROSSETTI.

R/W dog, big solid boy, well muscled, good head and mouth, moved well both ways.

3rd. Jones' SCRUMPY JACK

CLASS 4. NOVICE DOG (3, 1A)

1st. Maldens' LITTLE BROWN JUG AT LOUKA.

Head lacking just a little, good neck, straight front, good bend of stifle, moved better in this class, as with all this lady's dogs well shown and handled.

2nd. Andersons' BULLBRIT DOUBLE DEALING.

Happy white with patch, not entire, head lacking in turn, good bone.

CLASS 5. POST GRADUATE DOG (6, 1A)

1st. Steels' CHARLES MONTGOMERY.

White dog well made, good head & mouth, moved well would like to see a bit more weight on him

2nd. Williams' MERLINDAN NIGHT OWL OF HULLABULLOO.

White with large eye patches, well made dog. Good head and neck. Shown Well.

3rd. Richards' YBRAD SIMPLY RED.

CLASS 6. OPEN DOG (5, 1A)

1st. Fairhalls' FIELDHALL CHEEKY CHAPPIE

White dog on his toes making his handler work, filled head with wicked expression, good mouth, nice bend of stifle, nice compact dog

2nd. Langs' LUSTYGLAZE TOTAL ECLIPSE

Heavyweight white dog, good in fill but lacking a little in profile, big boned.

3rd. Richards' YBRAD SIMPLY RED.

CLASS 7. VETERAN DOG OR BITCH (3, 2A)

1st. Tylers' RADCLYFF FOXTROT.

7 year old Br/White bitch, good head, mouth fault, a nice bitch who enjoyed herself.

My co-judge Chris Mellor and I came together at the end and were in complete agreement that the bitch Neverland Cards On The Table was Best In Show, a beautiful Br/White with a filled and turned head, good body shape in good condition who moved well. RBIS and BOS went to the dog Neverland House Master and Best Puppy went to the dog Briden Carbon Copy. We called in the Res best bitch to challenge the dog for RBIS, Stint & Williams' Samandal Sweet Bodicea an almost Solid brindle who was well made with a good head, mouth just off, moved better in front than behind.

BITCH CLASSES: 28 Bitches (34 Entries, 18 Absent)

SPECIAL BEGINNERS BITCH (2, 1 Abs);

1st, Lawrence & Sakkas' **Rebecca Silver Gem**: Black Brindle, nice all round bitch. Straight front, tight feet. Head has good profile with enough width, unfortunately mouth undershot. Moved close at rear straight coming.

PUPPY BITCH (6, 3 Abs);

1st, Bomel & Evans' **Mistlebrook Affray**: White bitch, with same side black eye and ear patch. Lovely head with sweeping profile, filled right up and wicked eye. Mouth has level bite, straight front, well-angulated back end but moved close at rear better coming.

2nd, Williams' **Terjo's Little Miss Dynamite of Hullabulloo**: Very classy elegant white bitch. Still immature at only 6 months, lovely feminine head with nice profile, perfect mouth. Excellent straight front, moved very choppy at rear. Shame about the missing part of her ear.

3rd, Payne's **Terjo's Rose in June**

JUNIOR BITCH (4, 1 Abs);

1st, Stint & Williams' **Samandal Sweet Bodicea**: Solid Black brindle, liked this bitch a lot. First class head with stunning profile and eye. Mouth correct. Shapely body with good topline and straight front. Would like better quarters, but they could develop with maturity. Movement not good.

2nd, Brooks' **Cwmdulais Ice Maiden at Kellouacy**: White with two brindle ears, decent head with correct mouth. Front nice and straight, slightly high at back end. Would prefer more leg length at front, moved close at rear, slightly wide coming.

3rd, Langs' **Cwmdulais Touch of Frost at Lustylaze**

NOVICE BITCH (5, 3 Abs);

1st, Adlam & Rose's **Soladream Devlin**: Tricolour, good head with nice arcing profile, could possible have a touch more fill. Mouth correct. Nicely angulated back end, moved parallel at rear but not as good coming.

2nd, Lawrence & Sakkas' **Rebecca Silver Gem**

POST GRADUATE (5, 2Abs);

1st, Taylor's **Bullycombe Guest of Honour at Chartay**: Brindle girl that should have brood bitch stamped on her forehead. Substantial bull type with massive chest, both depth and width. Head could do with more profile, perfect mouth, straight front with tight feet. Movement close at rear but nice and straight coming.

2nd, Lawrence & Sakkas' **Rebecca Silver Gem**.

3rd, Dance's **Aurmaru Scirocco at Decadance.**

OPEN (9, 6 abs);

1st, Best Bitch & BIS; Haddock's **Neverland Cards on the Table:** Beautifully marked Brindle. Good head with profile and width, perfect mouth and wicked eye. Nice neck leading into shapely sturdy body with solid back end. Moved parallel with drive at rear, and straight coming. Best moving bitch of the day. To be critical would like tidier feet and better ear set, but she deserved to be best bitch and I was delighted she was also best in show.

2nd, Lawrence & Sakkas' **Rebecca Silver Gem.**

3rd, Dance's **Aurmaru Siminol At Decadance.**

BROOD BITCH: (3, 2 Abs);

1st, Bomel & Evans' **Boarean Breen:** Nice Sturdy bitch, with decent head but could have done with more width. Mouth level, kind eye. Front nice and straight with tight feet. Movement not good.
