Special Beginners Dog.

1st Place. No 2 Kellouacy The Patriot.

Well marked black brindle dog. Very well filled and turned head, slightly undershot.

Moved squarley both ways.

2ND Place. No 38 Jaggers Wonder.

Nice old boy of 7 years, well made white, lacking the turn to his head of no 1, good straight front, moved well both ways.

3rd Place. No 10 Taurine Dartmoor Prince.

Puppy Dog.

1st Place No 14. Taurine Better The Devil Uno.

Upstanding white dog, well filled head needs a little more turn. Correct mouth. Good forehead, with level topline.

2nd Place. No 4 Funfair Eddy.

Very cobby solid brindle, well turned and filled head, correct mouth. Nice short back, a little immature at 6 months.

3rd Place No 10. Taurine Dartmoor Prince.

Junior Dog.

1st Place No 22 Marshelsea Cwmdulais Dai Another Day.

Striking white dog. Beautiful front. And forechest. Head turned and filled right up, with perfect mouth. Wicked eye somewhat lacking in the breed today.

Moved well in front a little closer behind. A little shorter back would be ideal. My Best Dog today.

2nd Place No 1 Eiramsel Abisha At Evaduse.

Well marked brindle well turned and filled head correct mouth. A little light in bone but still quite young. Moved freely both ways.

3rd Place No 59. Chartay Lord Of The Ring.

Novice Dog.

1st Place No 43. Megacosmic Total Eclipse.

Black and white dog, well filled head, correct mouth, could use more turn. Slightly round eye.

Moved well coming a little close going.

2nd Place. No 66. Santibliri Lad.

Well made compact black brindle. Nice turn and fill to his head correct mouth. Nice front and short back when he did move he was good in front closer behind.

3RD Place No 45. Red Warrior.

Limit Dog.

1st Place No 66 Santibliri Lad.

My second place in previous class could benefit from handling classes. A nice little dog when you can see him.

2nd Place No 38 Jaggers Wonder.

Well made old boy was also second in Special beginners class.

3rd Place No 45.

Open Dog.

1ST Place No 41 Merlindan Sentinel.

Powerful white boy. Very nice head filled and turned, correct mouth. Very nice front and forechest. Moved well coming closer in rear, I would like to see him with a shorter back.

2nd Place No 55 Briden Carbon Copy.

Well marked black brindle dog, good turn and fill to his head. Correct mouth, good forehand, with good movement.

3rd Place No 66 Santibliri Lad.

Veteran Dog.

1ST Place No38 Jaggers Wonder.

Well made white dog 7 years old. Head needs more turn, good front and forehand, level topline moved better than many youngsters today.

Special Beginners Bitch.

1st Place No 3 Kellouacy Lippy Chick.

Lovely well marked brindle bitch, very typy Head well turned and filled. Good eye mouth correct. Nice reach of neck flowing into short back. Moved a little close behind better in front.

2nd Place No 26 Siarcdir Kira Nerise.

Very nice headed black and white. Well turned and filled. Good front and spring of rib. Not quite the finish of No 1.

3rd Place No 40.

Puppy Bitch.

1st Place No 61 Trinity Of Peace.

Lovely compact white, good turn and fill to her head correct mouth, nice short back. Moved better in front than behind.

2nd Place No 47. Miramax Misty Blue

Young white girl, quite elegant, well turned head I would like a little more fill, good mouth. Nice straight front, level topline, well angulated rear end.

3rd Place No 44 Angel River..

Junior Bitch.

1st Place No 11. Ducassos Polar Princess.

Very compact white bitch. Lovely short back. Sweeping arc to her head with good fill, correct mouth, eye could be meaner. Nice front with deep forechest, moved well both ways.

2nd Place No 56 Ducassos Right By Me Briden.

White girl very well arced head, good eye, straight front, level topline, would like a little more bone.

3rd Place No 64. Crossfire Dark Desire.

Novice Bitch.

1st Place No 5. Kearby Curacao At Mistlebrook.

Very typy black brindle girl, cobby, good turn and fill to her head mouth slightly wrong. Powerful front and forechest. Level topline with nice short back.

2nd Place No 37. Terrakuler Geordie Girl.

Very elegant tri bitch. Nicely turned head needs a little more fill up. Eye a little round.

Lovely front and topline.

3rd Place No 65. Crossfire Guns N Roses.

Limit Bitch.

1st Place No 50. Monarchs Mischief.

Striking white girl, well turned and filled head, correct mouth. Dead straight front, moved well front and rear, right up on her toes.

2nd Place No 33. Bulbrum Porcelain Queen.

Very typy elegant white, not quite the turn on her head as No 1. Good deep forechest and straight front. Level topline with good rear angulation, moved well both ways.

3rd Place No 34. Karmara Cause A Commotion.

Open Bitch.

1st Place No 42. Icacía Tallulah Of Merlindan.

A striking all white, head turned and filled right up, correct mouth, good eye, and well placed ears. lovely forehead, with straight front. Good depth of chest, nice length of neck, and short level back. Good rear. Movement true both ways. She owned the ring, and was my Best Bitch Today. And Best in Show.

2nd Place No 62. Tiger Lily Of Astasia.

Another lovely bitch. Well marked brindle, smaller terrier type, very nice make and shape. Good turn, could use a little more fill to her head correct mouth. Elegant flowing neck to a level short back. Lovely straight front. Moved well in front a little closer in rear. Expertly handled, she was a picture. Just losing to No 1 on substance today. I made her Reserve Best Bitch.

3rd Place No 21. Targyt Dusky Dawn Dodecote.

Special Brood Bitch.

1st Place No 51. Bullbrit Prarie Rose.

Well made white girl, great spring of rib, good straight front. Well turned and filled head Correct mouth.. Moved well in front.

2nd Place No 7. Boarean Breen At Mistlebrook.

Short backed white, good turn on her head not quite the fill of No 1. Good reach of neck and level topline. Straight front and good rear angulation.

3rd Place No 19. Astonian Ariadne At Gordons Glen.

Best in Show No 42. Icacía Tallulah Of Merlindan.
