CLASS 1 – SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG (3,3)

1st – Woodward's **Chartay Crowning Glory**: Brindle; moderate strength to head; good ear set; nice eye; well laid shoulders; good topline and tail set; nice bone; strong pasterns & tidy feet, which weren't common today; moved freely but a little close behind. 2nd – Lhomme's **Brigand Band of Briden**: large brindle; slightly longer cast than 1st dog; super head and expression but unfortunately carrying a mouth fault; good eye and ear placement; good angulation front and rear; movement adequate both ways. 3rd – Case & Fox's **Cwmdulais Witch Finder**:

CLASS 2 – PUPPY DOG (1,1)

1st – Bolt-Lawrence's **Shacadia's Dream Lover**: a young white dog with a striking expression and good head carriage; very strong fill to foreface & sweeping profile; strong teeth & correct bite; needs to body up in time but carrying good bone & nice overall balance; straight front; correct topline and tail set; movement a little erratic and distracted today.

CLASS 3 – JUNIOR DOG (5,3)

1st – Brown's **Meridianview Monkey Boy**: Small, smart well-marked mahogany brindle; lovely bone for size and overall good balance to this dog. Strong, filled head with good expression; nice eye and correct mouth; good ear set leading into strong neck and correct topline and tail set. Straight front and good rear angulation; a little close but moved with drive and purpose; great showman. **RBD**. 2nd – Brooks' **Totally Osbourne at Kellouacy**: large, heavyweight well-marked tri colour; tremendous bone; large, strong, packed, long muzzle; correct mouth but not having quite the profile of 1st and a little longer cast; nice neck and shoulders with correct topline but carrying a bit too much weight for me; moved well both ways. 3rd – Atkin's' **Hentarwurban Explotion**:

CLASS 4 – NOVICE DOG (0,0)

Class 5 – Limit Dog (6, 5)

1st – Quinn's **Padhen Abraham of Lincoln**: large tri colour; good make and shape; good clean hard condition; nice unexaggerated yet strong head; good mouth; good length of neck leading into lovely topline; straight front; lovely round bone; good feet; slightly reluctant on the move but in super condition and a credit to his owner. 2nd – **Membury's Mitzstaff Diamond White**: White; good strong filled head; good eye;

correct shoulder and straight front; slightly longer cast; moved well. 3rd
– Shearman & Rodgers **Shacadia's Big Bopper Dog**:

Class 6 – Open Dog (4,3)

1st – Fenton's **Stockleyview Dark Desire**: eye-catching large dark
brindle; super, strong head with long, well-filled muzzle; nice eye shape
& correct ear placement; correct mouth; strong neck; good shoulder
placement and nice straight front; good spring of rib; well angled rear;
moved well when settled **BD; RBIS**. 2nd – Ley's **Fortifer Fiammetta**:
well marked red dog; lovely head and expression; super showman with
great ring presence; lovely eye but ear set could be better; mouth fault;
good reach of neck and super topline and tailset; moved well both ways;
pressed hard for first; 3rd – Carter's **Kilacabar Constantine of
Loquitur**:

CLASS 7 – VETERAN DOG OR BITCH (7,3)

1st – Smalley's **Briden Carbon Copy**: medium sized smart black brindle;
well presented; strong filled head; good eye & ear set; good teeth for
age; lovely coat and condition; moved well. 2nd – Malden's **Shanson
Black Shadow at Louka**: elegant black brindle bitch; very feminine
head; good length of muzzle; out of coat today but still showing off her
quality; moved with purpose. 3rd – Malden's **Louka Lady in Red**:

CLASS 8 – SPECIAL BEGINNERS BITCH (3,3)

1st – Joy's **Moonshine Strikes Twice**: white with black ears; cracking
profile; super eye; lovely mouth; elegant lines; straight front; athletic
movement; best feet in the show; nice overall balance just needs to
mature. 2nd – Malden's **Shanson Black Shadow at Louka**. 3rd - Malden's
Louka Lady in Red

CLASS 9 – PUPPY BITCH (4,3)

1st – King's **Bobuddy Pearly Queen at Bullbrazen**: white, medium
sized, well balanced bitch; beautiful head proportions and set on to
elegant neck and correct shoulders; short coupled; good topline; moved
purposefully **BP** 2nd – Ley's **Tiny Tinkerbelle at Mansuetude**: medium
sized white bitch with red ears; beautiful in outline; super eye; mouth
fault; good shoulder and topline; straight front but feet could be better;
moved well. 3rd – Shearman's **Santapod Babe**:

CLASS 10 – JUNIOR BITCH (5,5)

1st – Karta's **Karmara Cause a Catastrophe**: large white with tri eye
patch; strong head; large but well balanced body with strong neck and
shoulders; could be stronger at pasterns; nice topline & tail carriage;
movement adequate. 2nd – Ley's **Fortifer Fortune**: Black brindle; well
proportioned; good rib; straight front; great condition; moved well both
ways. 3rd – Roff's **Bobuddy Enigma**:

CLASS 11 – NOVICE BITCH (8,6)

1st – White's **Stockleyview Enchantress**: brindle bitch; lovely filled head with long strong muzzle; reluctant showgirl who didn't want to use her ears but handler got the best out of her when it mattered; nice body and spring of rib; good shoulder and rear angulation; strong topline; movement adequate. 2nd – Smalley's **Briden Dame Blancae**: small white bitch; filled head; mouth fault; lovely square outline; well constructed so unsurprising to see great movement. 3rd – Godsall's **Terjo's Blue Moon over Neverland**:

Class 12 – LIMIT BITCH (6,4)

1st – O'Neil's **Merseybulls Ruby Tuesday**: well made, medium sized red; good head; correct mouth; strong neck and topline; straight front; tidy feet; moved well both ways. 2nd – Godsall's **Terjo's Blue Moon over Neverland** 3rd - Malden's **Louka What Popped out of the Hat**

Class 13 – OPEN BITCH (6,4)

1st – Membury's **Mitzstaff Ice Maiden**: medium sized white with red ears; striking in outline & super balance; packed head with wicked eye and overall expression; good reach of neck and correct topline & tail carriage; correct spring of rib; straight front; moved well & well presented **BIS** 2nd – Malden's **Louka Lady Luck**: white with good strong head and nice proportions; strong bone; out of coat today; moved well. 3rd – Bond' **Merlindan Zenzation**:

1st – Malden's **Shanson Black Shadow at Louka**: 2nd – Malden's **Louka Lady in Red**: 3rd - Malden's **Louka What Popped out of the Hat shcm**
